
Daylight Savings This Sunday! March 10, 2019

Advocacy in Action: Justice. Freedom. God's Mission. March 11-14



Child Development Center at First Baptist Church 50 Years of Education

The Child Development Center originally opened in 1969 as a place for families to send their children as mothers were starting to go off into the workplace. Moray Loring, the Associate Pastor of Education at First Baptist Church at the time, dreamed of opening a preschool connected through the church and with the help of church members, that dream became a reality. When those first preschoolers walked through the doors in 1969, Loring had no idea the legacy that she would leave behind. Since opening 50 years ago, staff at CDC have helped in teaching thousands of Columbia's youth.

\$50 For 50!

In celebration of their 50th year of quality preschool education, the Child Development Center is asking church members to donate \$50 to help replenish their scholarship fund. Since opening in 1969, the Child Development Center has had a rich history of serving children of lower economic status through the scholarship fund.
